MHFA Australia has developed a Older Person Mental Health First Aid (OMHFA) Course for families and carers assisting people aged 65+. The aim is to train the community to respond appropriately as early as possible to older people developing mental health problems, rather than wait for a mental health crisis before taking action.

What the course covers:

- Learn the signs and symptoms of the common mental health problems in older people
- How to offer initial help, where and how to get professional and other help
- What sorts of help has been shown by research to be effective, and how to provide first aid in a crisis situation.

Mental health problems covered are:

- Depression
- Anxiety problems
- Confusion and dementia
- Psychosis.

Mental health crisis situations covered are:

- Suicidal thoughts and behaviours
- Panic attacks
- Delirium
- Challenging and Unsafe behaviours due to confusion

Course participants receive a copy of the Older Person MHFA Manual to keep and the opportunity to sit an online exam to become an accredited first aider for 3 years.
